We like the lead-in phrase, "We have a profound passion for..."

Through the dialogue ideas were written in different "bishop columns;" the bolded phrases are from the original document sent by the bishops.

Vision Equity

"TO LOVE GOD, LOVE PEOPLE AND MAKE DISCIPLES" VISION: "To bring wholeness to the world through healthy biblical communities of holy people multiplying disciples, leaders, groups and churches."

"When at the Methodist conference... what may we reasonably believe be God's design... to reform the nation, particularly the church and to spread scriptural holiness over the land"

Will's Summary Recommendation

If we were to lead with distinctiveness in the list and end with an increasing move toward orthodoxy we could both show off our history and our current anchoring as an evangelical movement. Imagine a list that sounded like this (using words expressed by bishops plus one further idea) The further idea is the original statement of scriptural holiness. What if we borrowed that adjective for "authority:"

We are profoundly passionate about:

- Life-Giving Holiness
- Love-Driven Justice
- Pervasive Multiplication (center idea is disciple-making)
- Global Synergy
- Scriptural Authority (leave this to end as a definitive "period")

This as a "top level" articulation has a surprising stickiness to it with regard to syllable count and consonance. It's actually hard to forget this list once you hear it. You have the 2-step lead in with life and love and the sound of "s's." Ending the list with the two "y's" enhances the sound.
